# WELCOME TO THE 9th EDITION

The Great British seaside is an evocative place – a place of fun, where all our rules become just a little relaxed.

The Out There Festival is very much a celebration of this, bringing a mix of mirth, mayhem and world class culture onto the streets for EVERYONE to enjoy.

2016 marks nine years of festivities bringing together Great Yarmouth and visitors from across the UK and Europe. The genesis behind Out There was always about building an event to extend the town's tourism offer and celebrate its rich international nature.

This year the festival is presented in partnership with Greater Yarmouth Tourism and Business Improvement Area Ltd (GYTABIA). Together we've developed our seafront and evening programme to capitalise on one of Great Yarmouth's finest attributes – the Golden Mile. Highlights include the world premiere of Gorilla Circus' *Altitude* (p21) and the enthralling *Carousel* by Southpaw Dance Company (p18).

SeaChange have joined the Without Walls consortium which will bring exciting new outdoor work to Great Yarmouth over the next few years. We've also embarked on a new national project, *Coasters*, with the ambition of reimagining the cultural offer of coastal towns, touring exciting work such as Worldbeater's mesmeric *Spark!* (p19). Out There is also one of the key events in *Look Sideways – East*, a lively initiative celebrating and promoting Norfolk and Suffolk culture to national audiences.

At a time when BREXIT remains the phrase on everyone's lips, we are exploring how we continue to bring the wealth of international talent to communities here in Great Yarmouth. Aside from its artistic impact, European funding has significantly supported the running of the festival over recent years. While it will inevitably be much harder to deliver international performances of this calibre, in this quantity, to the festival in future, we'll be exploring how artists and organisations can continue to collaborate without European support in our professional symposium this year, *It's Not (All) About the Money* (p25).

Our home, the Drill House has undergone a £1.5 million facelift to begin work to transform it into a fit-for-purpose circus and street arts creation centre. We officially re-open over the festival and host Pickled Image's *Coulrophobia* (p6) in the main hall. The Drill House will be the 'engine room' of much of the festival's content going forward and you'll be able to see a few of those shows, including TrashDollies' *Cape Alley* (p12) as part of this year's programme.

As always, we encourage you to get out there and imbibe the wondrous, surprising and astounding world of Out There – see you soon!

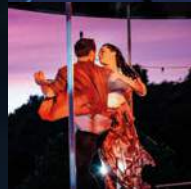
# FRIDAY NIGHT OUT THERE KICKS OFF! THE SEAFRONT MARINE PARADE
