They express themselves in a language of four arms and four legs, giving birth to one body with which they speak the language of the juggle. It's true that 1+2=3; but in this case the two is for *us*, we can only give one to them, because it is as one that they move.

Through their endearing, conflicting, incensing games, their choreography is a voyage of juggling movement: they go from loneliness to togetherness, from random to reason, from soil to sky, from silence to storm.


Physical contact provokes juggling, and it`s this that prompts movement.

### • TECHNICAL FILE •

Times: -forme courte 20mn divisible en deux parties -forme longue 40mn (sortie mai 2017)

Times for instal : 1h (si réglage son 2h et lumières prévoir 4h00 minimum)

Times for uninstall: 20mn

Stage area: Minimum of 7x6m and a height of 4m (possibility of adapting itself to the place, in this case there, the company has to arrive the day before the representation).

This show takes place outdoor as indoor, frontal and half-circular.

**Sound**: Plan a sound system in stereo and a computer to receive one USB keys and a technician for our pips sound (if there is no computer, is needed an arrival jack in bottom of scene so that we can make our pips sound, ourself, since a tablet).

Lights: At night or indoor, the ideal lighting in height lights is:

- -6 PC 1000w in front
- -5 PAR64 in back
- -6 PAR56 in floor

Plan the adequate lights as well as a service of 4 hours with a technician.

Plan a space warmed out of sight and of the rain, 2 hours before the representation for the heatings.


