That was a great day! As outdoor work is key in the recovery of live events, we created Cycle Circus as a direct response to Covid-19 drawing on our experience of safely restarting live events.

TOUR PACKAGE

Cycle Circus is an outdoor 30 - 40 minute experience (10 – 20 minute parade and 20 minute show). A self-sufficient, environmentally friendly performance that needs no technical support and can to be performed up to 4 times a day in different locations, all reached by bicycle. Suitable for festivals, events and community gatherings in urban and rural settings. We perform wherever people live, work and play: in streets, car parks, parks, fields, farmyards, rooftops, outside nursing homes, direct provision centres, and more... Cycle Circus is an accessible, live, high quality artistic experience that celebrates circus and Irish culture.

REQUIREMENTS AND COVID-19 SAFETY

Cycle Circus is designed to be self-contained and has very few requirements:

- Ideal performance area: minimum floor space of 6m x 6m, minimum height of 6m (clear of branches, wires etc).
- Ideal¹ performance surface: a flat surface with no incline, and please let us know if it's hard ground or grass.
- **Crew/Marshalls:** 2 crew/marshalls to manage audience. We can organise this for an additional fee
- Get in: 30 minutes before the first experience of the day
- Get out: 20 minutes
- Sound system: Battery operated, provided by Tumble Circus
- LX: Lights with operator to be provided by event organiser for evening / night shows
- Set: N/A

¹ Cycle Circus is all about flexibility and adaptability so if this isn't possible, let us know

- Access: On arrival we require parking for 2 x vans (Ford Transit, LWB and high roof). This will be our central point for preparing and getting changed for Cycle Circus and from there we will cycle to the different performance locations.
- **Changing rooms:** for 5 performer with light refreshments (water, tea, coffee, and fruit) and big enough to warm up in and to socially distance
- Accommodation: if required 1 x single and 2 x double rooms
- Covid-19 Safety: Our Company Covid Policy, Cycle Circus Risk Assessment and Protocols are available on request.
