Welcome to the XTRAX / SIRF 2021 Outdoor Arts Showcase, presented in association with Stockton International Riverside Festival (SIRF).

Since 2001, XTRAX Showcases have brought people together to see fantastic outdoor projects, network with colleagues around the world, and learn about this inspirational sector. Building on the enormous success of our inaugural SIRF showcase in 2019 and our online SIRF showcase in 2020, we are delighted to present an online programme of events on 28 - 29 July.

As you may already know, the Stockton International Riverside Festival was planned to go ahead in person this year, with over 40 artists performing at the festival 28 July - 1 August. Unfortunately, on Friday 16 July, SIRF had to take the difficult decision to cancel the event due to the rising rate of COVID-19 infections in the local area and the current pressures on emergency services. Whilst this is very disappointing news for all concerned, we are delighted that our online showcase events can proceed as planned.

We are using the virtual event platform Swapcard to facilitate our online showcase this year, which offers an incredible range of opportunities for delegates. SWAPCARD ONLINE PLATFORM

How to use our Swapcard Virtual Event Platform

To facilitate the XTRAX / SIRF 2021 showcase we will be using virtual event platform Swapcard, which offers a number of enhanced networking opportunities for delegates.

In comparison to a simple webinar or Zoom call, Swapcard offers the ability to update your profile to showcase your work, explore delegate profiles, sit virtual exhibitor booths, save your schedule and bookmark sessions and contacts, contact one another and set up meetings and groups.

Registration

To access the platform, you first need to make sure you have registered for the showcase. You can do this by heading to the XTRAX website.

Once you have registered for the XTRAX/SIRF 2021 Outdoor Arts Showcase, you will receive an email invitation from Swapcard giving you access to the platform. Clicking the link in this email will take you through to the platform.

*We would recommend saving the Swapcard platform url to your Bookmarks or Favourites on your web browser once you have entered, to make it easier to return to.

Update your profil

The details you entered when registering will appear on your Swapcard profile, which you can find by clicking 'Edit' on the left hand side of the Homepage, or by clicking the dropdown arrow on the top right corner of the platform and selecting 'My Profile'.

Here you can update your bio, image, contact details and social accounts. You can also add a Company profile to your bio, which will allow other delegates to see more about your company, as well as allowing other team members registered to the event to add the company to their profile.

View and save your schedule

Next up, head to the 'Programme' section and save which sessions you would like to attend. You can do this by clicking on the small Calendar icon at the end of each session title

This will save your schedule to the 'My Event' section of Swapcard, so you can easily see and access which sessions you are attending.

Explore our virtual Exhibitor Hall

Visit our virtual Exhibitor Hall to explore the artists and organisations behind the showcase. Here you can chat to and book meetings with pitching artists and supporting organisations.

By clicking on the small house icon on each exhibitor booth you can save exhibitors you're interested in to your 'My Event' section, so you can come back to them later.

Network with other attendees

In the 'Attendees' section of Swapcard you can find our delegate list. All delegates have a profile set up with their bio, images and information about their work. You can use the 'Category' filter on the left-hand side to find different types of delegates including artists, promoters, supporting organisations and professionals associated with artists.

If you want to chat to or meet with another delegate, you need to make a 'connection request'. Once the delegate has accepted this request, you're free to book in meetings and start networking.

Attendees you've connected with will also appear in your 'My Event' section, so you can see who you've met at the event.

In the 'Speakers' section you'll be able to see the profiles of our panel discussion speakers and hosts. Here you can send connection requests and bookmark them, just as you can with other attendees.

Attend online sessions

The Swapcard platform is the place to find and attend our online sessions. All you need to do to attend a session is head to 'Programme' and click the session at the time of the event.

Our sessions come in different formats, some may be live streamed via YouTube, others directly on the platform, and some via Zoom. You'll find instructions on how to join each session in the session description.

Export your contacts and connections

At any time until the end of the event, you can export the contacts you've made, exhibitors you've saved and sessions you've attended from your 'My Event' section. This is a great way to keep track of who you've connected with and continue to develop those relationships after the showcase finishes.

Air Giants create enormous interactive beings and spaces which have an emotional effect on audiences. We are inspired by natural movement and our work explores human-robot interaction in an accessible way that brings people together. We aim to spread wonder, joy and escapist magic. Our team has experience in robotics, software engineering and design, and our output is squarely at the intersection of art, science and technology. We seek out strange and wonderful projects and collaborations and love to make things happen.

The towering plants are illuminated and inflatable, and the forest is filled with sound and light. Robotic technology throughout the installation means that the plants know when audiences enter and they move in response; unfurling, blooming and blossoming to create a connection. It's a chance to step out of the everyday and into a magical world. *Unfurl* is an interactive and immersive robotic forest of 8 5-metre tall active inflatable plants. The technology throughout the forest means that the plants know where audiences are. The plants respond to audiences but also to each other, creating rippling, synchronised effects throughout the forest.

Under the helm of Creative Director/Choreographer Johnny Autin, **AutinDT** (Birmingham, est. 2013) produces innovative and aspirational artistic performances that are often socially and politically engaged, and provides extensive learning and education programmes in the community.

Autin Dance Theatre's outdoor show is a tale told in two parts – an interactive promenade and a physical theatre duet – which transports its audiences into another world, to tell a story about our own world. Through dance, movement and masterful puppeteering, **Out of the Deep Blue** dives into the themes of the climate emergency and the biodiversity crisis in an outdoor spectacle featuring a 4-metre tall Puppet operated by 5 world-class puppeteers and contemporary dancers.

Based in Penzance in Cornwall, **Bash Street Theatre** has built an international reputation performing fast-moving, silent-comedy shows with live musical accompaniment. Since their first performance in Morlaix, France in 1991, partners and co-founders JoJo Pickering and Simon Pullum have created 25 different productions and performed at major festivals in more than 20 European countries, as well as in Egypt, Turkey, Israel, Japan, Hong Kong, Macau and South Korea.

Set 'sometime in the future', a jaded detective looks back on his early career as a young crime-fighter in the 2020s - the days of fake news, a world pandemic and global warming. In a playful homage to the film-noir genre, with a voice-over narration and live musical accompaniment, including piano and accordion, four performers play a multitude of characters. There is topical intrigue, mistaken identities and silent comedy as the storyline follows the fortunes of an inept cameraman who inadvertently becomes the main witness in an international robbery worth millions of dollars - the theft of the Covid vaccine formula.

Oiveira & Bachtler create work rooted in human nature, generating a unique and multifaceted physical language supported by circus, theatre and movement. With great regard for ambience, they compose to evoke visceral and scenic paintings into the space. Founders of Oliveira & Bachtler (Hugo Oliveira and Sage Bachtler Cushman) have performed, created, directed and taught in 19 countries expanding across 6 of the 7 continents. Their experience creating and performing spans an array of artistic languages such as opera, cabaret, dance, circus and theatre.

Two beings living in an abstract world, *Otus* is rooted in human nature. Here is a unique perspective, a glimpse into their lives, motivations, relationships and habits. Utilising circus, physical theatre, movement, clown and set design Otus explores tension, the space between objects and the wooden world in which they reside. With precarious piles of cut wooden planks, a rope, table and trapeze, their peculiar domain is set. Immersed in their own nuances and rendered through acrobatics, juggling, rope, trapeze and staff manipulation, their world unfolds.

Coração nas Mãos (Heart in hands), comes from the Portuguese expression "to be with the heart in hands". Which means to be worried or concern for a situation. It means also to do something with sincerity and frankness. The company arises from the passion of two sisters for the aerial arts. It manifests the will to do something sincere and honest, using the circus as a basis and as a vehicle for expression. Crossing it with the most different areas, it grounds on imagery, seeking to explore everyday and imaginary situations.

A rhizome is a stem that grows horizontally and underground, which can also have aerial growth. It grows without a defined direction and it is polymorphic. *Rizoma* is a work-in-progress about the philosophic theory of "Rhizome" from Deleuze and Guattari. A surrealistic adventure through the imagination. Visual poetry. Rizoma is a solo of circus, dance and theater of objects and animated forms that explores the techniques of handstand, acrobatics, and objects manipulation through the 'game' with a scenographic element: a big orange plant vase. The show explores the surrealism, through the body fragmentation, and all the possibilities that this body can reveal while occupying a vase: the inside, the outside, the below, the above.

An established live artist who uses humour, spectacle, collaboration and unusual approaches to audience engagement to create ambitious, accessible performances. I have created large-scale outdoor shows and innovative interactive performance theatre pieces. Audition Project brought 75 Live Artists onto the Birmingham Hippodrome stage to re-enact A Chorus Line for a "Redux" film. This work resulted in large-scale outdoor participatory events including live tour for Without Walls Festival audiences and online film starring the public.

Bird Rave brings together a diverse group of artists (Miss High Leg Kick, Steve Nice, Abi Cunliffe, Yoko Nishimura) to interpret bird movements for an interactive "dancefloor ornithology" performance. Bird Rave is a site-responsive, interactive show in which artists dressed in extraordinary bird costumes perform to a soundtrack of classic rave music. It uses the mechanics of a bird-watching experience to explore migration, group dynamics, and the choreography of nature (bird flocks; mating dances; nesting rituals).

Movema (est. 2009) is an award-winning world dance company run by 4 female artists from diverse cultural backgrounds (Chinese, Malaysian, Caribbean, Irish & British), based & working in the most deprived postcodes in Liverpool & Bristol. We celebrate diversity through dance, creating safe spaces for different communities to come together and learn about each other and creating high quality arts & culture experiences, including choreographed shows, parades, outdoor events & festival performances.

Inspired by Movema's experiences of migration & informed by refugee and asylum seeker communities with whom we work, Movema are creating an exciting, thought-provoking & spectacular performance work. Using the concept of 4 symbolic birds to represent futuristic cyborgs, whose bodies are part aircraft, part bird, part human; the Fenghuang (also known as Phoenix) from Chinese culture, the Peacock from Indian culture, the Sankofa bird from Ghanaian culture and the Liver bird to representing British & Irish culture. The work explores themes of migration, human relationship with technology, citizenship & belonging alongside Movema's signature playful & engaging world dance.
