2011-2015

- 2011 Organization founded
- 2012 Official registration completed
- 2013 First major annual production
- 2014 Became the first Taiwanese circus company to embark on an overseas tour

2016-2019

- 2016 Launched the cross-disciplinary “Circus Trilogy”
- 2017 Received funding through the Ministry of Culture’s Performing Arts Group Tiered Grants Program
- 2018 Continued organizational and artistic development

- 2022 Expanded creative programming and operational capacity
- 2023 First Edition Focasa Circus Festival
- 2024 Full time staff exceeded 30 members

Establish Taiwan as a hub for circus arts in Asia.

- 80,000 attendees over one week
- 30 performing groups from 8 countries
- A total of 15 international curators participated (from Asia, Australia, Canada)

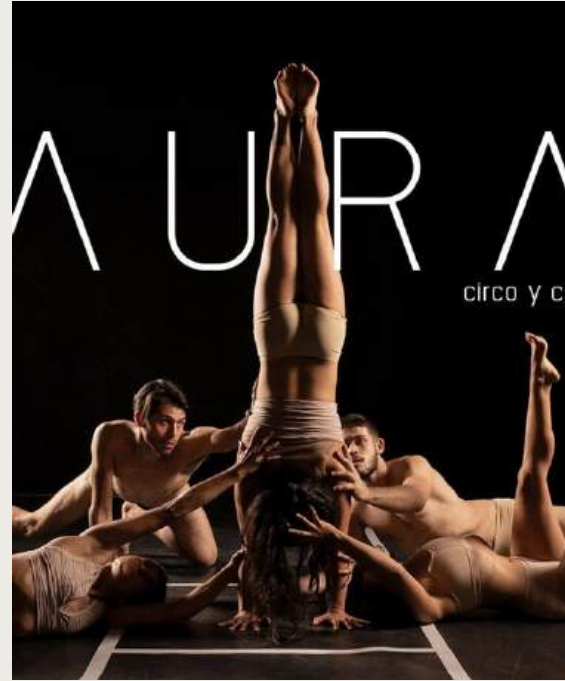
