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Technical Specification & Requirements

Arrival & Parking

- We like to arrive 90-120 mins before our first set.
- We require parking for one or 2 vehicles.
- Primary vehicle is always a long wheelbase, high-top van – 5.5m x 2.6m.
- Unloading area as close to dressing room as possible.

Load-In

We really prefer that the audience/public doesn't see the un/loading procedure!

- Trolleys are unloaded via motorcycle ramps from the van to the ground and then ridden to the designated trolley backstage area.
- **Our machines are heavy and don't do stairs:** we need same level, ramped, or goods lift access to backstage area and performance area.
- Doors & aisles a minimum of 36"/92cm wide.

Backstage – Trolleys

Public/audience must not be able to see the trolleys on standby/backstage!

- Covered area with access to 240v power, 13amp supply - each trolley draws less than 1 amp.
- Minimum 2 x 2 m per trolley.
- We set up and then leave the trolleys on standby/charge in a designated area before and between sets.
- We require free access between dressing room and trolley area at all times.

Backstage – Performers

- A secure & warm dressing room area with lights and electricity.
- Tables and chairs per performer.
- Hot and cold refreshments.
- Catering is always appreciated!

Accommodation

- If we are required to commence travel before 7am, or arrive home past 10pm we will usually request accommodation to be provided.
- Single rooms, including breakfast, per performer.
- Parking included for van.

Performance

- We can ride on most terrain – not snow, ice, mud or loose/rutted surfaces.
- We like to play our music and sound effects **LOUD** – please take this into account when considering performance area and scheduling.
- Most sets are 30mins long, we can perform for longer (like parades) but need advanced notice to adapt the batteries.
- We like 40 mins between sets.

Load-Out

- It usually takes approx 60-90 mins from end of last set to depart the venue/event.
